Entry Fee:	\$7.50 facility fee per swimmer, \$3.00 per individual event and \$5.00 per relay event. Deck entries are \$10.00 for each event plus the \$7.50 facility fee.
Deck Entries:	Deck entries are to be submitted to the Computer Operator no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. The fee for deck entries is \$10.00 per individual event. If the swimmer is not already in the meet, the \$7.50 facility fee is also due. Deck entries will only be placed in empty lanes and heats will not be reseeded for deck entries. Swimmers must still comply with the maximum per session and per day entry limits and other eligibility requirements. Swimmers may not scratch an event to deck enter a new event. Proof of USA Swimming registration must be met.

# TRINITY PREP AQUATICS Alternate Coaches Form May 4, 2013

**Camera Zones:** Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.12, Meet Management shall designate and inform the public of "Camera Zones" at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable "Camera Zones" may include, but are not limited to the side courses of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, turnend of competition course when not in use as a "start end," etc. Meet Management shall also designate "Non-Camera Zones." Under NO circumstances will Camera Zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Rule 239.2.
