## **Condition of Sanction:**

- 1. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- 2. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- 3. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Warm-up: 7 - 7:45 AM open warm up 16 lanes

**Eligibility:** On deck registration will not be allowed. \* Open to all currently registered USA Swimming swimmers

**Entry Limit:** 5 relay swims for the meet. Meet will be limited to 4 hours by the end of the 12 and under events.

\*No limit on relay teams, please designate as A, B, C, etc.

Seeding: \* Use 25 Yard Short Course times

Scratch Penalty: none

Team Representative: Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person other than the coach, who will check with the referee about any matter pertaining to the meet, may be given to the referee. For each team, The coach and that person only will be recognized.

Identification: Coaches and Officials shall wear their USA Swimming registration card in a conspicuous location at all times while on deck during a swimmeet.

Camera Zones: Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.12, Meet Management shall designate and inform the public of "Camera Zones" at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable "Camera Zones" may include, but are not limited to the side courses of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, turn-end of competition course when not in use as a "startend," etc. Meet Management shall also designate "Non-Camera Zones." Under NO circumstances will Camera Zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Rule 239.2.
