- Sanctioned:** Florida Swimming: #5139
- Condition of Sanction:** The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA-S.
- Type of Meet:** Age group/senior Invitational, 25 yard short course timed finals
- Host:** Tampa Bay Aquatics Swim Team
- Dates and Times:** Saturday June 26th, Sunday June 27th
Morning sessions will start at 8:00am both days
Afternoon sessions will not start before 12:00
- Warm up:** 7:00 am warm up on Saturday and Sunday
Minimum one half hour warm up prior to afternoon session start
- Location:** Ed Gandy Pool Complex

- Pool Specs:** Certified 25 yard outdoor heated pool, non-turbulent lane lines, 10 lane, water depth at start end 12ft. Paragon starting blocks, separate warm down area adjacent to competition pool
- Timing System:** Colorado Electronic timing with Electronic display
- Eligibility:** Only swimmers currently registered with USA swimming who are members of invited teams. Limited to the first 550 swimmers
- Entry Limit:** Four (4) individual events per day plus relays. Swimmers over entered will be placed in the first 4 events in which they entered for that session. No limit on Relays, relay entries should be labeled “A”, “B” etc.
- Seeding:** 25 Yard Short Course times, conversions using the formula in the current Florida Swimming handbook may be used for entry and seeding purposes.
- Scratches:** No Penalty for scratches on the block.

Entries: Entries must be in USA Swimming SDIF format or Hy-Tek CL2 format submitted on a Hy-Tek disk, or sent by email using Hy-Tek team manager. Corrupted, unreadable, or incorrectly formatted files must be corrected within 24 hours. Errors in entries are the responsibility of the registering team. Electronic mail confirmation will be sent upon receipt of file.

Preferred entry is via electronic mail attachment to:

Ridgeswim01@aol.com or by mail using a 3.5inch disk.

A signed hard copy printout also serves as proof of entry. The legal name and current USA Swimming Registration Number for each swimmer must be listed on the Entry Form, including Relay Only swimmers. The master entry form must accompany the proof of entries and a current USA Swimming member must sign the form.

Deck Entries: Deck entries will be accepted by the meet referee 45m prior to the session start. The deck entry fee is \$10.00 per event and must be paid at time of request. Deck entries will be accepted if space is available, no new heats will be created. Swimmers must comply with the entry requirements of the meet. A swimmer may not scratch to deck enter an event.

Entry Fee: \$6.00 per swimmer Meet Surcharge, individual events are \$2.50 per event for all age groups. Relays are \$4.50 per entry. Any team who does not use the Hy-Tek meet entry format will be charged \$50.00. Make checks payable to: Ridge Swimming Inc.

High Point Award: 1st – 3rd male and female each age group

Scoring: Individual: 11-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 Relays: 22-18-16-14-12-10-8-6-4-2
In the event that weather stops the meet, scoring will use the last completed event of that day to determine points scored for both team and individual awards.

Rules: Current USA Swimming rules will govern the meet
Safety rules as outlined by USA Swimming , and recommended by the Head Marshall, will be in effect during all warm ups and in all warm up areas.
No recall false start will be used as outlined in 102.14.48
Flyover starts will be used at the discretion of the head referee

Supervision: A current coach member of USA Swimming must supervise each swimmer participating in a Florida Swimming sanctioned meet during warm up and competition. An unattached athlete or an athlete not escorted by a coach member must check in with the meet upon arrival at the meet. Such athletes must find a substitute coach who will supervise him/her during warm up and competition.

Identification: Coaches and Officials shall wear their USA Swimming credentials in a conspicuous location at all times while on deck during a swim meet.

WARM UP SCHEDULE**No equipment is permitted**

Swimmers must enter the water feet first with at least one hand in contact with the pool deck' except when executing a controlled racing start, supervised by a coach.

7:35- 7:55 am controlled warm up, circle swimming lanes 3,4,5,7, 8

Controlled starts lanes 1,2,6, 9and 10, one way only
