- CONDITION OF SANCTION:** The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- HOSTED BY:** Brandon Sports and Aquatic Center; Blue Wave Swim Team [BSAC-FL)
- TYPE OF MEET:** Age group and Senior, 50 meter Long Course, Timed Finals
- DATES & TIMES:** Friday, April 30th, 2010; 3:30 p.m. warm-up/ 5:00 p.m. start
Saturday & Sunday, May 1st & 2nd, 2010
Morning sessions 7:00 a.m. warm-up / 8:30 a.m. start for 13 & older
Afternoon sessions 45-minute warm-up guaranteed. The session for 12 & younger swimmers will not start before 12:30 p.m.

- POOL SPECS:** One eight-lane, 50-meter outdoor heated pool, non-turbulent lane lines for competition. The diving well is available for warm up and warm down. Water depth at the competition starting end is a minimum of 4 feet 6 inches.
- TIMING SYSTEM:** Daktronics Timing System with scoreboard. Manual stopwatches for back-up. Hy-Tek Meet Manager will be used for scoring.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all 2010 USA Swimming registered swimmers. Limited to the first 450 swimmers or the first team to fill the four hour time limit per session. The BSAC reserves the right to return any entries that may exceed the limit.
- SEEDING:** 50-meter times will be used for seeding purposes. Conversions allowed using the formula in the 2010 Florida Swimming Handbook or those in Hy-Tek Meet or Team Manager.
- DISTANCE CHECK-IN:** Positive check-in in Blue Wave Swim Office is required for seeding in all deck-seeded events. Swimmers who are not checked-in and are not scratched may be allowed to fill heats only, on a first-come basis [must notify administrative referee). However, no new heats will be created. Please note check-in times listed in *Order of Events* section. Deck seeded heats will be swum fastest to slowest alternating Women and Men, scored separately.
- SCRATCHES:** No penalty for scratching on the block.
- ENTRY LIMIT:** Swimmers will be limited to four [4] individual events per day plus relays. Swimmers over entered will be considered in the first four [4] events each day. No limit to relay entries, but each entry should indicate "A", "B", etc.
Meet management reserves the right to cancel relays due to four hour time limit per session or weather constraints.

ENTRY FORMS & FEES:

All entries must be submitted on the Hy-Tek export format. Entries will be accepted via e-mail [to bluewaveswimming@hotmail.com](mailto:bluewaveswimming@hotmail.com). Completed and signed entry recap and coaching certification, along with master entry form, entry print, and payment must be received by day of the meet. Additional fee of \$50.00 will apply to a team who does not enter the meet using the Hy-Tek format. All entry fees must be received by the meet director before the start of competition. No teams or individuals will be permitted to compete until all fees are paid in full.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entry forms must be received on **Wednesday, April 21st, by 7:00 p.m.**

DECK ENTRIES:

Deck entries will be accepted to fill heats only - no later than 45 minutes prior to the session start. No new heats will be created. Each deck entry will cost \$10.00 plus facility fee, 7.50, if a swimmer is not already entered in meet. All deck entries must be paid and accepted by the Administrative Referee. Swimmers are not allowed to exceed the maximum entries per day, nor will they be allowed to scratch an event and replace it with deck entry if they are already entered in the maximum number of events per day.

AWARDS:

Individual Events: Ribbons for 1st - 8th place

Relays: Ribbons for 1st through 3rd ribbons

High Point Awards: Top three swimmers in each age group.

Heat Winners' Awards: Random heat winners receive a ribbon or commemorative award.

Special Awards: Best female and male performance tabulated by International Point Score (IPS) rating system. **Team**

Award: 1st -3rd place

SCORING:

Individual: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relays: 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

ULES:

Current USA Swimming rules will govern the meet. Safety rules, as outlined by USA Swimming, and as recommended by the Head Marshall, will be in effect during the meet, all warm-ups and in all warm-up areas.

STARTS:

Competition starts on the clubhouse [west end) side will be on starting blocks. All events will be started on the west end of the pool. No recall false start will be used as outlined in 102.14.48; if a false start is confirmed after the starting device sounds, the race shall proceed and the swimmer [s) will be notified at the completion of the race [no recall). Meet management reserves the right to use fly-over starts.

TEAM REPRESENTATIVE:

Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person other than the coach who will check with Referee about any matter pertaining to the meet must be given to the Referee. The coach or designated team representative will be recognized.

CREDENTIALS: Coaches and Officials shall wear their current USA Swimming registration card in a conspicuous location at all times while on deck during a swim meet.

COACH SUPERVISION: A current coach member of USA Swimming must supervise each swimmer participating in a Florida Swimming sanctioned meet during warm-up and competition. An unattached athlete or an athlete not escorted by a coach member must check in with the meet referee upon arrival at the meet. Such athletes must find a substitute coach who will supervise them during warm-up and competition.

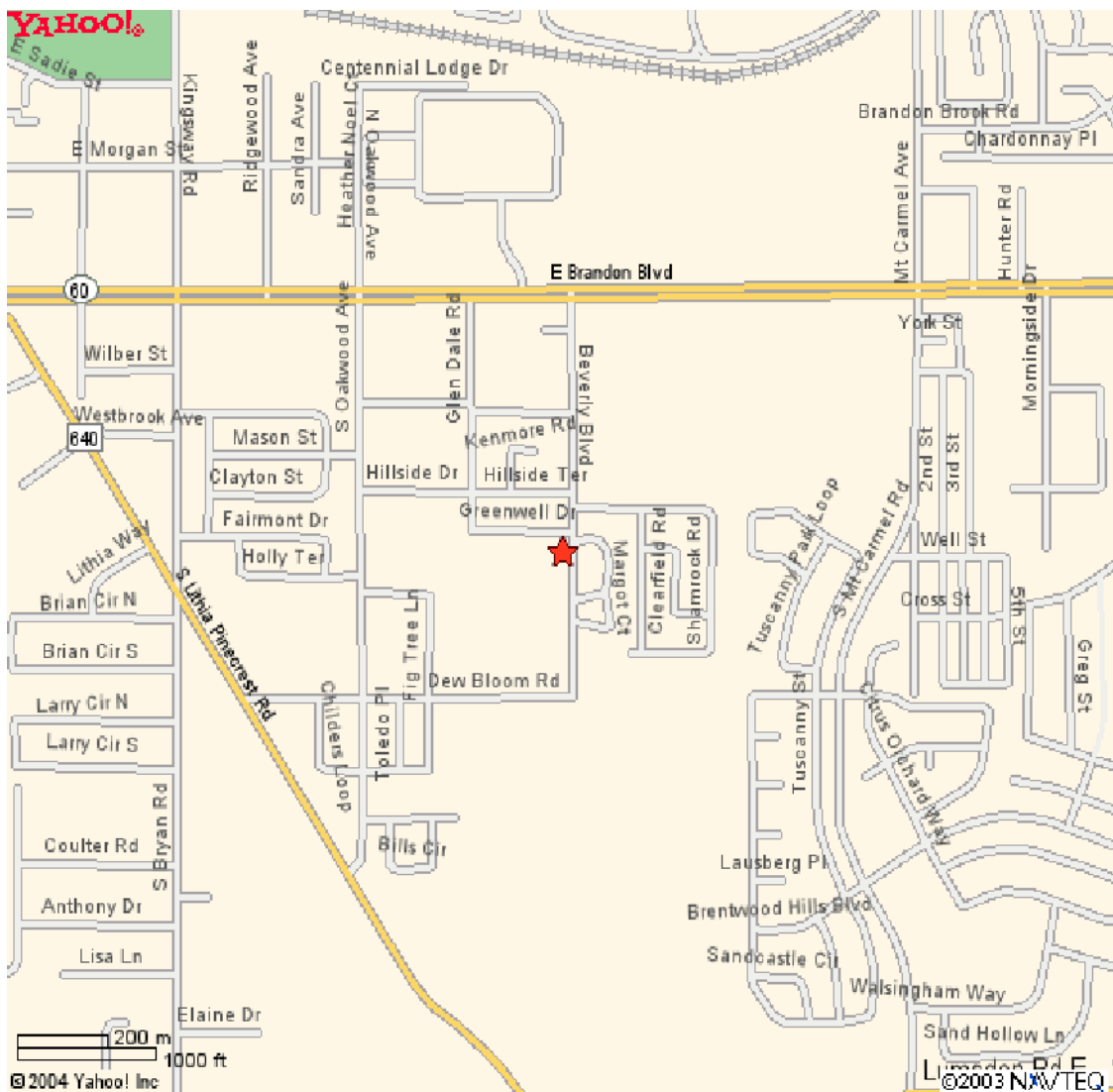
